I. Dynamic II. Nocturne III. Festive

Written for a New Year's concert with my friends Eric Le Sage and Paul Meyer in mind, this Sextet is pervaded by the spirit of clean entertainment and good humour. The first movement, « Dynamic », is a series of variations that ring changes on the rhythmic procedures inherited from American minimalist music. The central « Nocturne » is a gently sorrowful, intimate confession sung by the clarinet above a harmonic underlay in the strings and piano. Eventually the movement « Festive » sets free the feverish joy surrounding motifs among which may be found a nod toward Schubert's celebrated trout. The score closes with a cadential sneer.
